Our client's challenge

- **PIMCO** have always been on the hunt for ways to minimise the environmental impacts of their operations.
- With small kitchenettes and limited storage space, they were unable to use reusable crockery for staff mealtimes, so had to opt for disposables. Because of the risk of food contamination in recycling, that meant all disposables had to go into general waste - not their first choice!
- Hot on their agenda, **PIMCO** needed another solution for food disposables.

Our solution
